Buses from Barnstaple/Bideford/Bude: Service 319 (6 or 7 buses a day), from Exeter St Davids: Stagecoach 6 for Bude, change at Red Post for Stagecoach 219 or Stratton for Stagecoach 217 to Hartland village. National Express 502 runs during summer.
